What is "Crazy Pineapple?": You get dealt three cards preflop, do a round of wagering, deal out a flop, do a round of wagering, and then after the flop wagering is complete but before a turn card is dealt, each player still in the pot must discard (face down) one of their three cards. The turn and river are then played just like Texas Hold 'em.

*If players are all in before the turn, hands are not revealed until after action is complete and discards have been made.

**Any player holding 3 cards after the turn card is dealt will have a dead hand.

"Winners Shown":

The fan favorite inaugural event is back for an encore. You'll never need to ask, "if I fold, will you show?" **Winners Shown**: A winning hand must be shown before the pot is awarded.

"Winning hands" also include the last remaining hand after an uncalled bet/raise, stealing the blinds, etc. If you're the last person remaining in the pot you must show your hand before the pot is awarded. All your bluffs will be known! If you always have it, they'll know!

Penalties will be awarded to any player refusing to show a 'winning hand.' Penalties include warnings up to 1-round.

- All tournaments play 10 handed, and at 10 players remaining a seat redraw will occur.

- Clock will be rolled back to the beginning of the previous blind level at the start of the final table.

-10 minute breaks scheduled after levels 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 28. Breaks may be adjusted at tournament director's discretion.
